

Dairy Goat Registration Papers

Purebred or Registered Dairy Goats

Updated April 2020

This help sheet is intended to help you find the correct information when entering animal information into 4HOnline. Purebred Registration papers are always **blue**.

Name –
4HOnline **'Registered Name'** is the entire name. The first part of the name will always refer to the breeder's herd name.
'Name' is likely what the animal is called.

Breed –

Check the State Fair book for allowable breeds. Specific breeds should be entered for goats that are registered only.
*If you are viewing a paper in black/white, this is where you will look to figure out if the goat should be a Purebred or Recorded Grade.

Registration Number –

This is the same as the Registration ID.

Birthdate –

Double check for accuracy. This is important to put them into the right class at show.

Tattoo –

Registered animals should have a tattoo. RE indicates Right Ear, LE = Left Ear. Tattoos may also be under the tail in earless breeds.
