State CDM/Horticulture skillathons will be normal contests this year with a virtual contest as an option. Only in-person participants are eligible for awards. For more information, see the fair book. YQCA training is required for showing any animals. Last one is April 2 at 9am in Wessington Springs. A tentative schedule of Achievement Days was presented for Aug 2-4. Some changes were discussed to go to 2 days and put all animals on Monday and static on Tuesday. It will be discussed and finalized at the next meeting. A list of current 4-H members and volunteers was presented.

Movie tickets or cash will again be given this year for early completed projects. First drawing will be April 29th and second will be May 27th. DNA envelopes for market animals are due to the office by June 1. Envelopes can be picked up at the office. NUES tags are also available.

New business: County 4-H scholarships are due April 15th to the Extension office. 4-H online is now open for families to input their animal information. You will have until May 31 at 11:59pm to get this done. Companion animals are due Aug 10th. Traci made a motion to put an ad in papers for a bid to mow at the 4-H grounds. Ashley seconded the motion. Tina will take care of this. Dates are set for this year's 4-H teen camp. It will be June 20-23 and registration will open April 15. Poinsett will also have a camp on June 2-4. The Dairy cattle committee is offering a series of virtual Dairy judging contests this spring. We would like to offer youth chances to practice this spring and from their own home. Please feel free to share with families in your counties. Contest #1 will be open from Friday, March 12 to Monday, March 29 for scoring. After the 29th, the contest will be left open for practice only. Scores will be sent to the email address they provided and/or the County Office they indicated.

The state horse show will be held July 19-21 at a combination of the State Fair grounds and the Heartland rodeo grounds in Huron. The updated rulebook, etc will be published by April 1st as will the State fair book. County horse show will be in Sanborn this year.
